We pray for the sick and those who care for them, especially **Tricia Osman, Glyn Osman, Julie Romanelli, Bill Berry, John Matthias, Nigel Rees, Charles Murray, Ron Rowles, Doreen Balley, Nell Williams, Patricia Woodward and Miriam Burnell**. We pray for the repose of the souls of the departed, especially **Margaret Millicent Martin, Winifred Coleman and Julia Margaret Doe**, whose anniversaries occur at this time.
